What is Direct Supervision?

Home

A management philosophy which places staff in an open setting to be face to face with the inmates with full responsibility for the management of inmate behavior.



The First Transition



- Opening of Booking and Intake/Release building
- Enhanced procedures to ensure proper identification, classification, and timely release of all inmates housed in the facility



Booking and Intake/Release

- Computer technology for video imaging
- Inmate jail management system
- A.F.I.S. (Automatic Fingerprint Identification System), an electronic inkless fingerprint system.





Direct Supervision



- Frequent nonscheduled observation of and personal interaction with inmates
- Deputy stations inside the inmate housing areas
- Order and control is maintained to ensure continued direct contact between deputy and inmates





- Housing units provide optimum visibility for deputies in order to monitor inmate behavior
- Staff and inmates protected from assaults
- Direct monitoring, privileges, leadership skills, and set standards are utilized for the deputy





Direct Supervision

OFFERS:

- Inmate community based living
- Lowered noise level
- Positive inmate behavior
- Inmate response to positive guidance
- Lowered stress on deputies
- Fewer inmate behavioral problems
- Educational enhancement programs
- Less vandalism resulting in a cleaner facility
- Reduction in inmate assaults on other inmates and staff
