

<u>News Release</u> SCSO arrests Oviedo man for video voyeurism

Seminole Co. (Nov. 23, 2016) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) yesterday arrested James Kuethe, 53, of Yalaha, on one count of video voyeurism after he took photos of a female shopper.

At approximately 3 p.m., deputies responded to a report of a suspicious incident at Walmart located on Deep Lake Road, in unincorporated Oviedo. Upon arrival, deputies spoke with store personnel who indicated that a shopper reported she believed a man inside the store took photos up her dress. The entire incident was captured on store video cameras and showed Kuethe, a deliveryman for a store vendor, crouched over with a cell phone pointed up the victim's dress.

Kuethe left the store without completing the delivery and before deputies arrived. The vender who employed Kuethe was contacted and provided deputies information on his identity and his next scheduled delivery location. Deputies located him there and took him into custody without incident. This investigation is ongoing and it is unknown if he has victimized others.

Kuethe was charged with one count of video voyeurism and booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility on a \$3,000 bond. He is currently still in custody.
