Subject arrested after firing dozens of shots along roadway

Seminole Co. (November 14, 2017) Seminole County Sheriff's deputies arrested a suspect accused of firing dozens of rounds along a local roadway, striking multiple cars and forcing closure of the road. No one was injured.

Just before 11 a.m. Monday, witnesses reported shots coming from a vehicle parked at the intersection of Oklahoma Street and County Road 426. Five vehicles nearby were struck. A sign and an ornamental statue located at two local business were also struck. Part of County Road 426 was shut down while deputies investigated.

40-year-old Marc Anthony Garcia was taken in to custody at the scene. Two handguns were found in the vehicle. Another subject, believed to be a passenger in the vehicle, was not charged.

Garcia was transported to a local hospital to be medically cleared. Monday evening he was booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility on more than a dozen counts including aggravated assault and firing a deadly missile into a dwelling or vehicle.
