## SCSO seeks public's help locating missing/endangered juvenile

Seminole Co. (Dec. 07, 2017) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is asking the public for help locating a missing/endangered 12year-old girl. Halie Pixton was last seen yesterday at approximately 4:30 p.m. at her home located in the 800 block of Shell Lane in unincorporated Longwood. According to Halie's mother, she left the residence on foot after they had a verbal disagreement and has not returned home.

Halie is 5'4' tall, weighs approximately 100 lbs., with long brown hair and brown eyes. A photo is attached to this release. She was last seen wearing dark jeans and a red hooded sweatshirt with the word "chill" written down the sleeve. She was carrying a black and white suitcase with clothing inside.
