## "Operation Christmas Clean-up"/Box Disposal

Seminole Co. (Dec. 22, 2018) - To reduce the opportunity for post-holiday crime, the Seminole County Sheriff's Office has partnered with Waste Pro USA to implement "Operation Christmas Clean-up".

Leaving boxes on the curb in front of your home can have the unintended effect of advertising your new holiday gifts to potential burglars by signaling to them what you have inside. To make it convenient for you to safely dispose of your gift boxes and/or packaging, cardboard only recycling bins will be available at locations throughout the county from December 23 – January 8 at the following locations:
