Investigators seeking public's help to find armed burglary suspects

Seminole Co. (May 1, 2018) - Investigators are seeking the public's help to identify two suspects responsible for an armed home burglary and multiple vehicle burglaries in the 300 block of Moffat Loop in unincorporated Oviedo.

The investigation began on April 21, 2018, when one of the victims contacted the Sheriff's Office. Early that morning she woke to the sound of a door slamming and witnessed a suspect walking past her front window. When the suspect opened the door to her vehicle parked in the driveway, she banged on the window causing him to run.

One suspect was armed with a small revolver; another can be seen wearing a multi-color hoodie. It was determined these suspects earlier had entered the victim's residence through an unlocked garage door, and a door left unlocked leading into the home. Once inside, suspects stole keys and other items before exiting. Two vehicles, one in the garage and another in the driveway had also been burglarized.

Deputies canvassed the area and determined vehicles at three nearby residences had also been burglarized.
