Seminole County (June 13, 2018)—Sheriff Dennis Lemma is among law enforcement, public health, and education leaders featured in a new public service announcement on the opioid crisis in Seminole County and the holistic approach being taken to fight it.

On the front lines, Seminole County deputies are now all equipped with Narcan, the opioid inhibitor which has proven successful in saving the lives of dozens of overdose victims.
