Silver Alert issued for missing and endangered senior

Seminole Co. (July 14, 2018) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is asking the public for help locating a missing and endangered 64-year Noel Galkin, of Lake Mary.

Mr. Galkin was last seen this morning when he and his wife were driving separately to drop a vehicle at the Tire Kingdom located on S.R. 434 in Longwood. Mr. Galkin took a wrong turn, and his wife lost sight of him. According to family members, Mr. Galkin has Alzheimer's disease and other medical conditions that require medication. He does not have a cell phone; however, he may have made a purchase at a gas station in Daytona Beach at approximately 12:22 p.m.

Noel Galkin is a white male, 5'11" tall and weighs approximately 195 pounds. Mr. Galkin has white hair and a beard, and green eyes. A clothing description of what he was last seen wearing is not available. Mr. Galkin is believed to be driving a silver Toyota Camry bearing Florida tag number Y76VJL.
