Life-Saving Deputy to be Honored at Inaugural Seminole County Sheriff Foundation Dinner

Seminole Co. Fla.(Sept. 19, 2018)-Seminole County Deputy William Dunn, will be honored by the Seminole County Sheriff Foundation at the inaugural fundraising dinner.

In June, Deputy Dunn located and rescued a three-year-old girl left alone in a hot car. Doctors later credited Dunn's actions as key to the child's survival. She has since made a full recovery. The child's mother was arrested and is facing criminal charges.
