SCSO investigating homicide in Longwood

SEMINOLE CO. (May 3, 2014) -- Investigators with the Seminole County Sheriff's Office are investigating a homicide which occurred last night near the 800 block of N. US Hwy 17-92 in Longwood.

At approximately 10:20 p.m., deputies responded to this location after receiving a call about a stabbing. Arriving deputies found the victim, Mark A. Vincent, 32, suffering from a stab wound. Vincent was pronounced deceased on scene by first responders.

Investigators determined that Vincent got into an argument with a male known to him, which resulted in Vincent being stabbed. The suspect then fled the location on foot. An extensive search for the suspect yielded negative results.

The suspect is identified as Justin Glenn Miller, white male, date of birth 02/12/91 (see attached photo). A warrant for homicide has been issued for Miller.
