Sem. Co. Fla., (10-12-11) -The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is asking the public for help in identifying two attempted armed robbery suspects.

On 10/6/11, at approximately 1:30 a.m., deputies responded to the YMCA located at 665 Longwood-Lake Mary Road, in Lake Mary, in reference to a possible attempted armed robbery. The victim, a YMCA facility maintenance employee, told deputies that he was leaving work for the evening when two males approached him in the parking lot. The suspects hit the victim in the head and attempted to rob him, but quickly fled the scene in a small vehicle, possibly a Honda.

The suspects are described as Hispanic or possibly black males in their late teens to early 20's. One suspect had a black handgun, was wearing a dark colored hoodie, and had a goatee and freckles on his face. A composite sketch of that suspect is attached.
