

SCSO Releases Additional Information in Sanford Shooting - 03/14/2012

Seminole Co. Fla., (3/14/12)-The Seminole County Sheriff's Office continues to seek information about the individuals involved in yesterday's shooting on Ronald Reagan Blvd. and 417 in Sanford, Fla.

At approximately 5 p.m., occupants in a black, four-door sedan opened fire on two passengers in a black GMC Envoy traveling southbound on Ronald Reagan Blvd. The driver of the Envoy, Joseph Lamar Thomas, B/M, 29, was hit in the neck but was able to drive to Seminole County Animal Services on Bush Boulevard where he was met by paramedics. He was transported to Orlando Regional Medical Center. His injuries are not life threatening. The passenger in the Envoy, Roger Derrel Williford, B/M, 30, was not injured.

There were two shooters in the sedan and both used handguns. There may have been additional occupants in the vehicle. The sedan is a newer model, with dark tint on the windows. It was described yesterday as a Honda Accord, but investigators believe the vehicle could have been a passenger vehicle of a similar make and model. Investigators continue to seek information from anyone who may have witnessed the incident, or have information about the vehicle or the shooters.
