

Seminole County Sheriff's Office to hold Annual Awards Ceremony tomorrow - 05/31/2012

Seminole Co. (5/30/12) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) invites the media to attend the Annual Awards Ceremony tomorrow as the agency honors the outstanding accomplishments of employees, volunteers and community members.
