

Seven arrested in drug trafficking ring - 06/21/2012

Seminole Co. Fla., (06/21/12)-The Seminole County Sheriff's Office City/County Investigative Bureau (CCIB), Sanford Police Department and the Drug Enforcement Administration this morning arrested seven suspects for conspiracy to sell and/or traffic illegal drugs.

The investigation began in February when investigators obtained information pertaining to a cocaine and pharmaceutical drug trafficking organization that was believed to be operating in the city of Sanford. The main target of the investigation, Michael Floyd, was supplied cocaine by co-defendant, Latron Thomas. The investigation into Floyd and Thomas subsequently lead to the identity of five additional suspects also arrested today.

Investigators believe the group is responsible for the sale and exchange of large quantities of cocaine and pharmaceutical drugs. More arrests in this case are expected as the investigation continues.
