SCSO makes arrest in felony littering case

Seminole Co. Fla., (Feb. 3) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) today arrested Alan Davis, 61, of Altamonte Springs, for felony littering and two misdemeanor nuisance charges for violations found on his property located at 349 Alpine Street in unincorporated Altamonte Springs.

On Sept. 3, 2015, SCSO's Code Enforcement Unit led a clean up of Davis' property after a special magistrate declared it a health and safety concern. A crew spent nine hours cleaning up the property, collecting a total of 31.49 tons of trash and debris which included unsecured refrigerators, household appliances, metal, lumber, glass, tires, dismantled auto parts, a large amount of scrap building material, and buckets of stagnant water. Two junk vehicles were also removed from the property.

Following the clean up, the Sheriff's Office forwarded the case to the State Attorney's Office for their review. A warrant was subsequently issued for Davis' arrest.

Deputies conducted a traffic stop on Davis' vehicle this morning. He was taken into custody and arrested without incident. He was additionally charged with knowingly driving with a suspended license. Davis was booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility on a \$3,000 bond. His booking photo and capias request are attached to this release.
