SCSO seeks public's help locating missing/endangered man

Seminole Co. (June 28, 2016)- The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is asking the public for help locating 54-year-old Raymond Hosack.

Mr. Hosack was last seen at his residence on Beach Ave. in unincorporated Longwood at approximately 4:00 p.m. According to family members, Mr. Hosack has early onset dementia and Alzheimer's. He is believed to be on foot and often uses a branch or other object as a walking stick.

Mr. Hosack is 5'3" tall, 165 lbs., with gray hair and blue eyes. A photo is attached to this release. He was last seen wearing a blue and white checkered shirt and blue jeans.
