Investigators need public's help identifying an identity theft suspect

Seminole Co. – (May 26, 2017) – Seminole County Sheriff's investigators are asking the public for help identifying an identity theft suspect. The investigation began on May 11 when deputies responded to the Deer Run County Club in unincorporated Casselberry. Upon arrival, they spoke to the victim who indicated that on May 10 she was at the club and believes she accidentally dropped her debit card after making a purchase at the snack bar. As soon as she realized the card was missing, she checked her account and noticed several fraudulent charges.

Investigators reviewed video of the suspect purchasing golf related items at a nearby store. He is described as an older white male, wearing a white golf shirt, khaki shorts, flip flop shoes, and a white visor. Photos of the suspect are included in this release.

Anyone with information on this crime or the identity of the suspects is asked to call the Seminole County Sheriff's Office at 407-665-6650 or Crimeline at (800) 423-TIPS (8477). Calls made to Crimeline remain anonymous, and tips that lead to the felony arrest of suspects and/or the recovery of stolen property and drugs are eligible for cash rewards of up to \$1,000 dollars.
