Investigators need public's help identifying two burglary suspects

Seminole, Co. – (August 2, 2017) Seminole County Sheriff's Investigators are asking the public for help identifying two burglary suspects. The investigation began on July 8 at approximately 2:35 a.m. Deputies responded to the AT&T Wireless store located at 5938 Red Bug Lake Road in unincorporated Winter Springs. Upon arrival, deputies observed broken glass and the front door shattered. Headphones, speakers and batteries were missing from inside the store.

Video from inside the store shows two men believed to be in their late teens to early twenties placing the items in plastic trash bags. Both had their faces covered. One of the subjects can be seen running out of the store wearing pink athletic shoes. The video can be viewed [here](#).

Calls made to Crimeline remain anonymous, and tips that lead to the felony arrest of suspects and/or the recovery of stolen property are eligible for cash rewards of up to \$1,000 dollars.
