SCSO, Local Police Agencies Partner with Online Crime Mapping Service

Seminole County (July 20, 2018)-The Seminole County Sheriff's Office and local police agencies within Seminole County are partnering with a crime mapping and analysis service, CrimeReports.com, to help residents better understand where crime is happening in their communities.

CrimeReports bills itself as, 'the nation's largest collection of law enforcement agencies committed to transparency, public access, and citizen engagement.' CrimeReports.com collects police call-for-service data, then maps out results from these calls in an easy-to-understand online format. Members of the public can use this data to better understand crime and crime trends in their areas of interest. That information will include the date, time, event number, general location, final event type and a summary of what transpired.

Eight local police agencies are joining SCSO to provide citizens with seamless, countywide access:

Altamonte Springs Police, Casselberry Police, Lake Mary Police, Longwood Police, Oviedo Police, Sanford Police, Sanford International Airport Police, and Winter Springs Police departments.
