SCSO seeks public's help locating missing/endangered juvenile

Seminole Co. (July 25, 2018) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is asking the public for help locating missing/endangered 14-year-old Emily Miranda.

Emily was last seen last night at her home located on Ortona Court in unincorporated Winter Springs. According to family members, Emily became upset over a family matter and went to her bedroom. When they check on her at around 9:30 p.m., she was gone. Family members are concerned about Emily's well-being, as she recently made threats to harm herself.

Emily is a white female, 5'8' tall, weighs approximately 145 lbs., with brown hair and brown eyes. A photo is attached to this release. She was last seen wearing a peach shirt, bicycle shorts, and had her hair in a bun. Emily may have a bandage on one of her forearms.
