Detectives Conducting In-Custody Death Investigation

Seminole Co. Fla., (December 22, 2023) – The Seminole County Sheriff’s Office is investigating the death of an inmate of the John E. Polk Correctional Facility (JEPCF), Julio Angel Pabon-Delgado, 33, of Orlando.

Pabon-Delgado was arrested on Fentanyl Trafficking and other drug-related charges, December 14, 2023. On Thursday, December 21, at 11:30 a.m., Pabon-Delgado was discovered lethargic and unresponsive in his cell. He was transported to a local hospital, and subsequently passed away at the hospital Friday, at 7:06 a.m.

The investigation is active and ongoing at this time to determine all factors that led up to the death of Pabon-Delgado. An autopsy will be performed by the Medical Examiner to determine cause of death.
