CIVIL SERVICE BOARD MINUTES NOTE: THE MINUTES OF THE CIVIL SERVICE BOARD ARE NOT VERBATIM.

The Civil Service Board of the Seminole County Sheriff's Office met on March 3, 2021 via Go to Meeting. The Board Members present were Mr. Ben Newman, Retired Major David Diggs, Sgt. William Noonan, and Detention Deputy Taurius Burke. Director Bob Hunter, Manager Christy Peters, Manager Mark Rehder, and Senior HR Analyst Shelley West were also present.

The meeting started with a call to order at approximately 4:03 pm with roll call.
