Seminole Co. Fla., (August 3, 2015) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is holding a Career Expo, designed to draw qualified applicants for a variety of core vacant positions. The Expo is being held today, August 3rd, from 3 – 7 p.m. at 100 Bush Boulevard in Sanford.

The Sheriff's Office will be hiring for deputy sheriffs, detention deputies, communication specialists (911 operators), child protection investigators, school crossing guards, and correctional facility nurses.
