

## SCSO seeks public's help identifying unknown female - 09/05/2013

SEMINOLE CO. (Sept. 5) – The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is seeking the public's help identifying an adult female who was found at approximately 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Aug. 30th wandering on foot in the area of Hunt Club Boulevard and Wekiva Springs Road in Longwood.

The woman, who is believed to be approximately 60 to 65 years old, appeared to be suffering from a medical issue and was transported to a local hospital. The hospital contacted the SCSO yesterday to report the woman was in good condition; however, she has not been able to effectively communicate with anyone and her name and personal information is still unknown. It is uncertain if this is due to a language barrier or mental health issue. All attempts to identify her have failed and there have been no reports of missing adults in Seminole or adjacent counties.

She is a black female, approximately 5'3" tall and 120 pounds. She does not have any teeth, but appears to have had dentures at one point.
