

Apopka man arrested for possession, distribution of porn - 11/26/2013

The Seminole County Sheriff's Office Crimes Against Children Unit yesterday arrested Donald Murray, 49, of Apopka, on 10 counts of possession of obscene material/child pornography and one count of distribution of obscene material/child pornography.

Investigators yesterday executed a search warrant at Murray's residence after receiving information from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement that possible child pornography images had been detected and were associated with an IP address belonging to Murray. A preliminary forensic analysis of Murray's computer found child pornography and evidence that he was sharing the images with others.

Murray was booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility on an \$11,000 bond.
