**Three arrested for burglarizing a Fern Park residence**

Seminole Co. (January 31, 2017) – On January 30, the Seminole County Sheriff’s Office (SCSO) arrested Dylan Usma, 19, Ryan A. Aheran, 21, and Delano Diaz, 18, from Orlando, for their involvement in a burglary that occurred at an unoccupied residence in Fern Park.

At approximately 12:15 p.m., a sergeant conducting proactive patrols in the area, noticed a suspicious red Honda CRV with the front door completely open parked in front of the residence, located in the 100 block of Navel Drive in Fern Park. The driver of the Honda noticed the patrol vehicle and quickly sped away. The sergeant noticed the door to the home quickly close and three males running from the back of the house. A foot pursuit began as the three suspects jumped fences in order to avoid apprehension. The trio attempted to hide near a local business, but employees directed deputies to their location. All three were taken into custody without further incident.

As deputies were conducting a burglary investigation at the residence, the homeowners arrived and noticed many of their belongings missing. Several missing items were found in the possession of the three suspects and were positively identified by the homeowners as property that belonged to them.

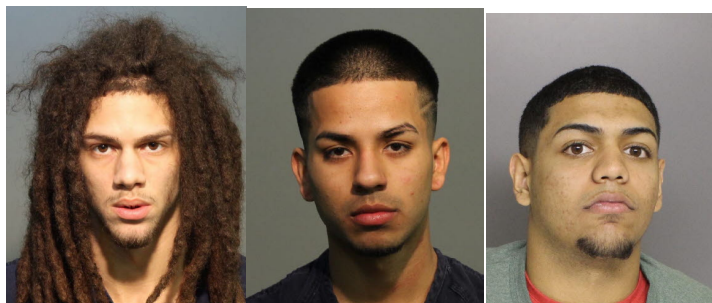
Usma, Aheran, and Diaz were charged with Burglary of an Unoccupied Dwelling, Grand Theft and Criminal Mischief. They were booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility where all three remain incarcerated on a \$11,250 bond.

The driver of the Honda CRV is still outstanding. The investigation is on-going. Anyone with information is asked to call the Seminole County Sheriff’s Office at (407) 665-6650 or Crimeline at (800) 423-TIPS (8477). Calls made to Crimeline remain anonymous, and tips that lead to the felony arrest of suspects and/or the recovery of stolen property and drugs are eligible for cash rewards of up to \$1,000 dollars.
