Suspect sought for Attempted Murder

Seminole Co. (March 31, 2017) –Seminole County Sheriff's investigators are looking for Jordan Morgan (DOB 04/14/1998) for a domestic related attempted homicide incident. A warrant has been issued for his arrest on the charges of Attempted Murder, Aggravated Battery, and Animal Cruelty.

On March 30 at approximately 10:20 a.m., deputies responded to 2730 N. Horizon Place in unincorporated Oviedo, in reference to a battery. Upon arrival, deputies spoke with residents who indicated Morgan struck his boyfriend in the head with the pointed end of a tactical tool. He then fled the home on foot in an unknown direction of travel. The victim was taken to a local hospital by friends and treated for non-life threatening injuries.

Deputies discovered Morgan also struck a cat in the head with the tactical tool. The cat sustained serious injuries and is being treated at a local veterinarian's office.

Calls made to Crimeline remain anonymous, and tips that lead to the felony arrest of suspects and/or the recovery of stolen property and drugs are eligible for cash rewards of up to \$1,000 dollars.
