Update on suspect sought for Attempted Murder

Last night investigators received information that Morgan was at a residence located on the 500 block of Breckenridge Village in Altamonte Springs. At approximately 8:30 p.m., deputies made entry into the home and found Morgan deceased with an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound. This incident is being investigated as an apparent suicide.

Suspect sought for Attempted Murder

Seminole Co. (March 31, 2017) –Seminole County Sheriff's investigators are looking for Jordan Morgan (DOB 04/14/1998) for a domestic related attempted homicide incident. A warrant has been issued for his arrest on the charges of Attempted Murder, Aggravated Battery, and Animal Cruelty.

On March 30 at approximately 10:20 a.m., deputies responded to 2730 N. Horizon Place in unincorporated Oviedo, in reference to a battery. Upon arrival, deputies spoke with residents who indicated Morgan struck his boyfriend in the head with the pointed end of a tactical tool. He then fled the home on foot in an unknown direction of travel. The victim was taken to a local hospital by friends and treated for non-life threatening injuries.

Deputies discovered Morgan also struck a cat in the head with the tactical tool. The cat sustained serious injuries and is being treated at a local veterinarian's office.

Calls made to Crimeline remain anonymous, and tips that lead to the felony arrest of suspects and/or the recovery of stolen property and drugs are eligible for cash rewards of up to \$1,000 dollars.
