Investigators need the public's help in identifying residential burglary suspects

Seminole Co. – (April 28, 2017) – Seminole County Sheriff's investigators need the public's help identifying two residential burglary suspects. The investigation began on April 27 at approximately 11:50 a.m., when deputies responded to the 100 block of Lake Blvd. in unincorporated Sanford in reference to an attempted burglary to an occupied residence. Upon arrival, deputies spoke with the victim who indicated one suspect approached the front door and repeatedly rang the doorbell while a second suspect attempted to gain entry through a glass sliding door located at the rear of the home. The victim yelled to the suspects, scaring them. Both suspects then entered a black sedan and fled the area.

The suspects are described as two black males in their twenties. A witness nearby was able to take several photos of one of the suspects as he ran to the black sedan. Those photos are attached to this release.

Anyone with information is asked to call the Seminole County Sheriff's Office at (407) 665-6650 or Crimeline at (800) 423-TIPS (8477). Calls made to Crimeline remain anonymous, and tips that lead to the felony arrest of suspects and/or the recovery of stolen property and drugs are eligible for cash rewards of up to \$1,000 dollars.

The Sheriff's Office reminds residents to follow these safety tips to avoid becoming a burglary victim:

- Call 911 immediately to report suspicious activity, persons, or vehicles.
- Always lock doors, windows and sliding glass doors, even when you are home.
- If you are at home and the doorbell rings, go to the door to investigate who is there and let them know that a person is inside.
