Deputies seeking to identify credit card fraud suspect

Seminole Co.- (August 30, 2017) – Seminole County deputies are trying to identify the suspect who made fraudulent purchases with a stolen credit card at a local department store.

The investigation began on August 26, when a resident received a phone call from her credit union inquiring about the purchases. The victim realized she had dropped her credit card while leaving the store. Store security provided images of the suspect who is believed to have picked up the credit card, gone inside the store and purchased gift cards.
