Deputies seeking missing, endangered 12-year-old

Seminole Co.- (October 14, 2017) — Seminole County deputies are seeking the public's help in locating a 12 year-old boy who was last seen at his Oviedo residence early Saturday afternoon.

Investigators from the Seminole County Sheriff's Juvenile Justice Division were called when the child, identified as 12-year-old Rasheen Middleton, left his residence on Healing Place in Oviedo. Due to the child's age, investigators say Middleton could be endangered.

Rasheen Middleton is a black male, 5'01/107 pounds with black hair and brown eyes. He was last seen wearing a green t-shirt, khaki long pants, and blue Nike sneakers.
