Deputies investigating homicide of local senior.

Seminole Co. Fla., (Oct. 23, 2017)-The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is investigating the homicide of an 87-year oldman in unincorporated Casselberry. A person of interest has been taken in to custody.

At around 9:00 am Monday, a friend went to the victim's home on Norwich Court to check on the welfare of 87-year-old Wallace Dean Worman. The victim's body was located inside the residence having suffered severe trauma. There was no sign of forced entry.

Through investigative means, a person of interest was located and taken in to custody. He is not cooperating with the investigation and is now jailed in Orange County on unrelated charges. It is unclear what connection the victim may have had with this person.

This is investigation is active and ongoing. We will continue to provide updates as they become available.
