Woman arrested for defrauding former employer

Seminole County (January 24, 2018) - Seminole County investigators charged a woman with three counts of fraud after she unlawfully used a credit card belonging to her former employer, and conducted fraudulent transactions totaling more than \$100,000.

The investigation began in February 2017 when the victim reported that a former employee, Desiree Cirrincione, 34, of Oviedo, fraudulently added herself as an authorized user on his personal credit card. She used the card to make numerous unauthorized purchases and cash advances over an eight-month period totaling \$104,423.66. It was discovered that Cirrincione attempted to hide the fraudulent purchases by using the victim's personal and business checking accounts to make payments on the credit card.

After an extensive investigation, contact was made with Cirrincione at her home yesterday and she was taken into custody without incident. Cirrincione was booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility on a \$32,000 bond. She posted bond last night and is no longer in custody.
