Seminole Co. (June 13, 2018) - Mr. Somers has been located and is in good condition. Thank you for your assistance.

SCSO seeks help locating missing/endangered man

Seminole Co. (June 11, 2018)-The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is asking the public for help locating a missing and endangered 29-year-old man.

Lakedrian Lavone Somers was last seen at approximately 1 p.m. today when he left his home, an assisted living facility on Dixie Way in unincorporated Sanford, with two unidentified black females driving a newer model SUV. According to family members, Mr. Somers is disabled, unable to make decisions on his own, and is without medication needed for several health conditions.

Mr. Somers is a black male, 5'11" tall, and 319 pounds. He has black hair and brown eyes. **A photo is attached to this release.** He was last seen wearing black shorts, a black shirt, and white sneakers.
