One dead, one injured after overnight shooting

Seminole Co. Fla., (Dec. 1, 2018) – The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is investigating a shooting incident that occurred overnight and left one man dead and another injured.

Last night at approximately 10:54 p.m., deputies responded to 3320 Sanford Avenue in unincorporated Sanford in reference to a possible shooting with injuries. Upon arrival, deputies observed Seminole County paramedics tending to an unresponsive male inside the home. The male, identified as Antonio Lamar Alston, 23, of Sanford, was transported to a local hospital; however, he was pronounced deceased shortly after arrival. Deputies then learned a second victim, identified as Senoula Presendieu, 26, (address unknown) was driven to the hospital earlier that evening and was also being treated for gunshot wounds. He is currently in stable condition and is not cooperating with investigators.

According to witnesses, multiple people were inside the home when an unknown disturbance occurred between four males. At least one of the males was armed with a handgun and fired several rounds striking Alston and Presendieu. The shooter and the other unharmed male fled the scene and have not yet been located.

The investigation is active and ongoing. All parties involved have been identified, and investigators are working strong leads on the whereabouts of the outstanding subjects. Calls made to Crimeline remain anonymous, and tips that lead to the felony arrest of a suspect and/or the recovery of stolen property and drugs are eligible for cash rewards of up to \$1,000.
