CCIB agents discover marijuana grow house in Longwood - 07/03/2012

Seminole Co. Fla., (07/03/13)-The Seminole County Sheriff's Office City-County Invest igative Bureau (CCIB) today arrested Jose Bernal Perez, 28 of Orlando, for operating a marijuana grow house in Longwood.

Agents obtained a search warrant for the property located at 1500 Sunshine Tree Blvd. after receiving an anonymous tip. The warrant was served early this morning and rev ealed a large-scale marijuana grow operation with 57 mature plants and a pound of pro cessed marijuana. The plants averaged over four feet in height and were located in t he garage and three bedrooms of the house. The plants and processed marijuana were s eized and the grow operation was dismantled.

A mature plant can yield a pound of marijuana per harvest and can produce three to fo ur crops per year. Agents estimate the street value of a pound of marijuana to be bet ween \$3,500-4,500. Each of the 57 plants could yield as much as \$18,000 of marijuana per year. The house had the potential to generate over \$1 million worth of marijuana annually.

Perez was charged with trafficking cannabis and was booked into the John E. Polk Corr ectional.
