SCSO Arrests High School Teacher for Unlawful Sexual Contact with a Minor

Seminole Co. Fla. (05/30/14) -- The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) Crimes Against Children Unit yesterday arrested William Nordin, 25, of Oviedo, on two counts of unlawful sexual contact with a minor.

On May 28, investigators received information of possible inappropriate text messages being sent between Nordin, a teacher's assistant and football coach at Haggerty High School, and several students. During the course of the investigation, it was discovered that a sexual relationship had occurred between Nordin and a 17-year-old female student. The inappropriate sexual contact is believed to have occurred over the past two months at Nordin's Oviedo apartment. This was substantiated following an interview with the victim by investigators.

William Nordin was booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility on a \$10,100 bond. He posted bond early this morning and is no longer in custody.

Investigators are looking into the possibility of additional victims and are asking anyone with information to call Seminole County Sheriff's Office at 407 665-6650.
