

NEWS RELEASE SCSO seeks help locating missing/endangered senior

Seminole Co. (May 31, 2014) -- The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is asking the public for help locating a missing and endangered 71-year-old man.

Sidney Jane Williams was last seen yesterday at approximately 10:30 p.m. when he left his home in Sanford in his vehicle. According to caretakers, Mr. Williams has dementia and is without medication needed for other conditions. He is believed to be driving a 2008 silver, Dodge Caravan with license plate G099GD.

Mr. Williams is a black male, 5'7" tall, and 145 pounds. He is bald and has a gray mustache. He was last seen wearing white shoes, blue jeans and a gray polo shirt with an orange stripe on it. Mr. Williams is known to frequent Burger Kings, gas stations, and areas along the St. Johns River.

Investigators have issued a Silver Alert. Anyone with information on his whereabouts is urged to call the SCSO at 407-665-6650.
