Seminole County Sheriff's Office investigating bank robbery

Seminole Co. Fla., (06-09-14) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is investigating a bank robbery that occurred this afternoon at the Chase Bank, located at 4190 West SR 46 in Sanford.

Shortly before 1 p.m., the suspect entered the bank and presented a note demanding cash from the teller. The suspect implied that he had a weapon however it was not seen. The teller complied with the suspect's demand and handed him an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspect then fled the scene on foot.

The suspect is described as a black male, thirty-five to forty years old, short hair, with a small amount of facial hair located just below his lower lip, approximately 5'8" to 5'10" tall with a medium build, with a scorpion or rosary tattoo on his right hand. He was wearing a tan baseball cap and a green polo shirt. A photo of the suspect is attached.
