SCSO Arrests Man for Unlawful Sexual Contact with an Intoxicated Juvenile

Seminole Co. Fla. (07/01/14) -- The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) Crimes Against Children Unit this morning arrested Sebastian Meleca, 23, of Oviedo, for unlawful sexual contact with an intoxicated juvenile.

On June 29, investigators received information of possible sexual contact between Meleca and a 16-year-old girl. During the course of the investigation, it was discovered that she and her 15-year-old friend met Meleca at a convenience store several weeks prior. They again met Meleca at the store on Friday and accompanied him back to his apartment. Once there, Meleca provided the juveniles with alcoholic beverages and both juveniles became intoxicated, with the 15 year-old becoming incapacitated. Meleca then proceeded to have sexual contact with both juveniles.

A search warrant was served on Meleca's residence last night and he was taken into custody. Meleca was charged with sexual battery of an incapacitated person and two counts of contributing to the delinquency of a minor. He was booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility on a \$25,100 bond. He has posted bond and is no longer in custody.
