#### **SCSO seeks help locating missing and endangered senior**

Seminole Co. (December 18, 2014) --The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is asking the public for help locating a missing and endangered 66 year-old man.

Leroy Jenkins was last seen at approximately 6:00 p.m. this evening when he left the Aiden Springs Assisted Living Facility located at 5520 Howell Branch Road in Winter Park, on foot. According to caretakers, Mr. Jenkins suffers from dementia and other health conditions which require medication.

Leroy Jenkins is a black male, DOB 7/25/48, 6'2" tall and weighs approximately 150 pounds. Mr. Jenkins has black and grey hair that he keeps braided and has a grey beard. Mr. Jenkins was last seen wearing a blue sweat shirt, blue jeans and possibly a dark colored hat. A photo is attached to this release.
