Man arrested for travelling to meet a minor for sex

SEMINOLE CO. (Dec. 23, 2014) - The Seminole County Sheriff's Office Crimes Against Children (CAC) Unit yesterday arrested John Mills, 49, of Melbourne, for soliciting a minor for sex, sending material harmful to a minor and traveling to have sex with a minor.

For approximately six weeks, undercover investigators chatted online, emailed, and spoke on the phone with Mills, who believed he was communicating with a 13-year-old girl. Yesterday evening Mills traveled to Seminole County intending to engage in sexual activity with the minor, but was met by CAC investigators instead.

Mills was booked into the John E. Polk Correctional Facility (JEPCF) and is being held on \$36,000 bond. He is scheduled to attend first appearance at the JEPCF today at 1:30 p.m.
