On October 29, 2011, Seminole County Law Enforcement agencies will be participating in the Drug Enforcement Administration's (DEA) nationwide prescription drug "Take-Back" initiative. Many people have medicine cabinets full of pills that are expired or no longer needed. These pills have the potential to cause great harm if taken by the wrong person. This is a great concern with the alarming increase in the rate of prescription drug abuse and thefts all across the United States. Flushing pills down the toilet or discarding them in the trash can also pose a serious environmental hazard. The "Take-Back" initiative coordinates the collection of unused, expired, or unwanted prescription drugs for safe and proper destruction.

- The program is free and anonymous.
- Collections will take place from 10 a.m. through 2 p.m.
- Prescription and over-the-counter solid dosage medication will be accepted, i.e. tablets and capsules.
- Intra-venous solutions, injection medication, and needles will not be accepted.
- Illicit substances such as marijuana or methamphetamines are not a part of the initiative.

Citizens are encouraged to drop off their unused medications at any of the 9 Seminole County sites listed below, no questions asked. Please do your part. Participate in the DEA's national "Take-Back" initiative and help prevent dangerous prescription pills from ending up in our landfills or from falling into the wrong hands.
