Seminole Co. Fla., (12/11/11)-The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is investigating an Aggravated on a Law Enforcement Officer.

At approximately 4:30 p.m., a Seminole County deputy working an off duty detail in Notting Hill Condominiums, in Lake Mary, attempted a traffic stop on a white Jeep near the front of the complex. As the deputy approach the driver, the suspect intentionally rammed the deputy's vehicle, also causing damage to two vehicles belonging to citizens. The driver then rammed the entrance/exit gate to the complex in his attempt to flee. During this time, one of the occupants tossed a gun out the window, which was recovered by deputies.

The suspects fled in the direction of S.R. 417, eventually crashing near Marshall Rd., in Sanford. All occupants fled on foot. One entered a home on Chase Ave and was captured. The second suspect was found hiding in a shed. A significant amount of drugs was located inside the suspects' vehicle. No one was injured during this incident.
