

SCSO to participate in Salvation Army holiday bell ringing - 12/16/2011

Seminole Co. Fla., (12/16/11)- Tomorrow, more than 45 members of the Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) will participate in the Salvation Army's "Adopt-a-Kettle" program. Deputies, Citizens on Patrol (CoP) volunteers, community service officers, and administrative personnel will serve as volunteer bell ringers at six locations across the county. The SCSO volunteers will man the kettle for the day, collecting donations in support of the Red Kettle program.

The Salvation Army's Red Kettle program began in 1891 and provides toys, clothes and dinners to needy families during the holiday season. The SCSO has participated in the program for the last 10 years.
