SCSO Deputy Dies in Line of Duty

Seminole Co. Fla., (12/26/11)- The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) mourns the loss of Deputy Matt Miller. Deputy Miller died in a traffic crash while on duty this afternoon. He was 53 years old.

Deputy Miller was a member of the SCSO motor unit and had served with the agency for nearly 24 years. He leaves behind a wife.

The crash occurred at 1:17 p.m. when Deputy Miller's motorcycle collided with a second vehicle at Maitland Boulevard and Gateway Drive in Altamonte Springs, Fla.. The second driver was transported to Orlando Regional Medical Center. The Florida Highway Patrol is investigating the crash.
