

Two suspects burglarize home and abuse family dog - 12/07/2012

Seminole Co. Fla., (12/06/12)- The Seminole County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is seeking the public's help in identifying two suspects who burglarized a Longwood home and hurt the family's dog.

On Nov. 30 at approximately 12:30 p.m., a residence in the 300 block of Beach Avenue in Longwood was burglarized. Deputies discovered the glass in a rear patio door had been smashed, and the house was in disarray. The suspects stole jewelry and electronics.

Upon returning home, the homeowners discovered Lilly, their three-year old pit bull, was missing. Review of the in-home video cameras showed the suspects taunting the dog and throwing a large object at her. It is believed Lilly escaped through the broken glass door. She returned home the next morning, scared and covered with welts. Lilly was treated by a local veterinarian and is expected to make a full recovery.
